



## **Sister Virginia Handrup Scholarship**

The Sister Virginia Handrup Scholarship was created by an anonymous donor to honor the enormous contribution that Sister Virginia has made to St. Joseph High School/SJCA over the years. This scholarship of \$2,000 will be awarded annually to a deserving female student who is returning to St. Joseph Catholic Academy for her junior year. The scholarship is for one year but may be renewable for the recipient's senior year.

The student applying for this scholarship must do the following:

1. Be a female entering her junior year.
2. Have at least a 3.5 GPA (Please attach a current transcript).
3. Exhibit exemplary standards in academics.
4. Be heavily involved in life at St. Joseph Catholic Academy and contribute to the fabric of the school and Kenosha community.
5. Complete a Financial Aid form in a timely manner, as required by the Admissions Office (financial need will be taken into account by the scholarship committee).
6. Submit an essay (no more than 500 words) on the following topic:  
"Name three gifts you have as a person and explain how you use them to benefit St. Joseph Catholic Academy?"
7. Provide two letters of recommendations, at least one of which is from a St. Joseph Catholic Academy teacher.

Please return this scholarship application, along with the required essay and letters of recommendation, to Wanda Jaraczewski, Director of Admissions, at St. Joseph Catholic Academy by March 31<sup>st</sup>. The recipient of this scholarship will be notified by mail on or before May 1<sup>st</sup>.
